

Daily Devotionals: With Jesus At The End | April 17, 2022

On Easter Sunday, a couple of women went to Jesus' tomb to anoint Him for burial, but when they arrived, He wasn't there. The tomb was empty, and an angel greeted them with the good news that Jesus was alive! The women hurried back to tell the others, and Jesus surprised His disciples by showing up in their midst.

Read Isaiah 52:7-10 and Luke 24.

Questions for reflection:

- Just as Jesus met with Cleopas and His friend on their journey, so too does Jesus want to meet us on our journey through life. How would you describe "where you're at" in your life journey? Where do you *feel* Jesus is in relation to where you are Behind? Too far out in front? Nowhere to be seen?
- Have there been times in the past where your eyes were blinded from "recognizing Jesus?" In what ways do you feel blind to His work and presence in your life right now?
- In the past, what events or experiences in your life helped you to see Him afresh?
- In your own words, describe what Jesus' resurrection means to you and why you're thankful for His sacrifice.
