



Revelation Week 5  
September 15 | Weekly Devotionals

**OPEN with prayer.**

Begin this devotional exercise by finding a quiet place where you can spend time with God in his word. Before reading, pray that the Holy Spirit would open your eyes and heart to what God wants to say to you.

**READ Revelation 4:1-11.**

- List out all of the descriptions of God and his throne that you find in Revelation 4:1-7. What do you think the descriptions of God, his throne, and what surrounds his throne in Revelation 4:1-7 mean?
- What attributes do the living creatures ascribe to God in Revelation 4:8?
- What do the elders do and then lay down before God in Revelation 4:10? What significance might this have for your life?

## **REFLECT**

- How does the vision of God on his throne challenge or deepen your understanding of his role in your life and the world?
- When was a time that you were confronted with the grandeur of God's presence? How did you respond? Are there areas of your life where you need to adjust your attitude or behavior in light of his majesty?
- In Revelation 4, God is worshiped simply because he is “creator.” Do you think of yourself as being *created*? As having a Creator? How would a deeper awareness of this knowledge shape how you live today?

## **PRAY**

Take anything that you reflected on above and spend time praying that to God. In your prayer time today, spend time praising God for his majesty and splendor and for being your Creator!
