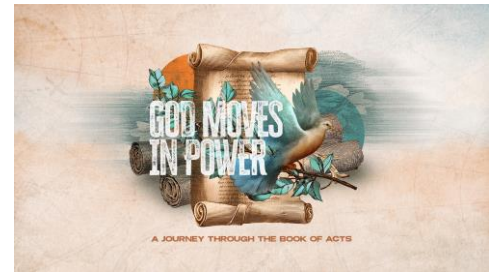


God Moves in Power: A Journey through the Book of Acts

Overview

The sermon series “God Moves in Power” is a journey through the book of Acts, where we witness the Holy Spirit at work through prayer, the gospel, the Church, and ordinary people. As we explore the story of the early church, we’ll discover that the same God who moved powerfully then is still moving today. This series will challenge and encourage us to live with bold faith, expectant prayer, and a willingness to join God’s ongoing mission in the world. The story of Acts is far from over and we’re invited to be a part of it. (Note: This series will explore the Book of Acts thematically rather than going through it chapter by chapter or verse-by-verse.)

For Week 1 of our reading plan through Acts, we will read through the whole book. Our aim is to get a picture of all the figures, events, and narratives that make up this text of Scripture. This will lay the foundation for us as we spend more intentional time in subsequent weeks.

- What do they teach or reveal about me personally?
